Important Notes

- All NHSN data corrections and updates must be entered into NHSN by the March 9th pull date to be included in the HSCRC QBR FY2017 rate year calculations. The Complex 30 Day SSI SIR which CMS uses will be pulled for HSCRC for CY2014 and CY2015 SSI COLO and HYST data.
- MHCC is no longer able to send email reminders for missing NHSN data. For MHCC public reporting purposes, hospitals will be given a preview report with approximately 1-2 weeks to update data in NHSN (see schedule for specific deadlines by HAI data category).
- MHCC is currently using the Complex A/R SIR for public reporting of all SSIs. The Commission will revisit this policy with the Maryland HAI Advisory Committee to determine if a change to use the CMS approach (Complex 30 Day SSI SIR) for COLO and HYST SSIs is appropriate to maintain consistency with data reported on Hospital Compare.
